Dear Parents/Carers

RE: Strike Action by the NEU taking place on Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May, 2023.

You will be aware from coverage in the media and from my letter to you all last week that members of the National Education Union (NEU) have declared strike action on the following days:

- Thursday 27th April
- Tuesday 2nd May

As previously mentioned, this strike action is taking place because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over pay and conditions – but also of the recruitment and retention crisis and the continued lack of funding and investments in education as a whole. This is not a decision that any teacher will have taken lightly. It is important to note that teachers are striking against the national educational policy and resourcing in schools and <u>not</u> against the children that they work so hard for every day.

To date, I can confirm that school will be open to all classes on Thursday 27th April.

On **Tuesday 2nd May**, Year 1 and 3 will be closed. Children in Year 1 and Year 3's attendance will **not be** affected by the strike day, as they will be coded as a Y (unable to attend due to exceptional circumstances). However, this means that you will now need to make alternative childcare arrangements for your child on this day if they are in Year 1 or 3. Remote learning for Year 1 and 3 will not be provided on this day.

If your Year 1/Year 3 child is entitled to free school meals, you will be able to collect a packed lunch from the main office from 12:00pm. If you would like a packed lunch, could you please make the school office aware by 9.00am on Tuesday 2nd May via email.

I am sorry about the potential disruption to your child's education and I fully appreciate that this will be challenging and frustrating for parents, which is why we have tried to provide as much notice as possible regarding this week's arrangements at our school. Thank you for your support and understanding.
